The Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) exam tests for a minimum level of competency in a particular engineering discipline. It is designed for engineers who have gained a minimum of four years' post-college work experience in their chosen engineering discipline.

NCEES PE Mechanical exam information

To become licensed, engineers must complete a four-year college degree, work under a Professional Engineer for at least four years, pass two intensive competency exams and earn a license from their state's licensure board. Then, to retain their licenses, PEs must continually maintain and improve their skills throughout their careers.

What is a PE? - National Society of Professional Engineers

The Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) exam tests for a minimum level of competency in a particular engineering discipline. It is designed for engineers who have gained a minimum of four years' post-college work experience in their chosen engineering discipline. The PE Civil exam is an 8-hour exam with 80 questions.

The April 2020 Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) (or Professional Engineer) examination will take place on Friday, April 17, 2020 and Saturday, April 18, 2019. Note: Applicants must register on the The National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES) website and pay for the exam booklet and grading process. Failure to register and complete payments on NCEES will prohibit approval to sit for the exam on the scheduled dates.

DCOPLA: Board of Professional Engineering

Once you have received approval from the New York State Board for Engineering, Land Surveying and Geology to sit for the NCEES PE exam, you must register through the NCEES website at www.ncees.org For computer-based format exams (CBT), you must register, pay for, and schedule your exams through your MYNCEES account.

Both the Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) exam and the Principles and Practice of Engineering (PE) exam are administered by the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES), whereas the South Dakota take home exam is administered by the South Dakota Board of Technical Professions.

There are two exams on the path to licensure as a Professional Engineer in Florida: the Fundamentals of Engineering and the Principles & Practice of Engineering. The FE exam covers subjects taken while earning a degree, while the PE exam goes beyond testing academic knowledge and includes expertise gained in the practice of engineering.

Engineering boards confer the P.E. license when licensure candidates meet a combination of requirements in education, experience, and exams. Before registering for an upcoming NCEES exam, review your unique approval and registration process by selecting your state, territory, or foreign entity from the map or drop-down list below.

NCEES engineering

The Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) exam is generally your first step in the process to becoming a professional licensed engineer (P.E.). It is designed for recent graduates and students who are close to finishing an undergraduate engineering degree from an EAC/ABET-accredited program.

NCEES FE exam information

The PE exam tests your ability to practice competently in a particular engineering discipline. It is designed for engineers who have gained at least four years' post-college work experience in their chosen engineering discipline. If you are a Texas Engineer in Training (EIT), you may register to take the PE exam.
