The difference between a persuasive and an informative ...

The informative speech conveys information, the persuasive speech is a call to action and the special occasion speech is given to commemorate a person or event.

Types of Speeches: Informative, Persuasive, and Special ...

An informative speech is only aimed at presenting given information, to educate and train. The persuasive speech is aimed at convincing you to believe or do something very specific. There is an end to whatever you are listening to, and more effort is put into keeping you entertained just so that you will act on whatever the speech was about.

Informative vs Persuasive Speeches - Difference

An informative speech aims to inform the audience about a specific topic. A persuasive speech aims to persuade the audience to perform a certain action or convince the audience to adopt the belief or opinion of the speaker. Many speeches will combine features of informative and persuasive speeches.
