In the same barrage a mortar blew up near Lieutenant Murphy throwing him to the ground. The shrapnel, which normally consists of large jagged pieces of razor sharp metal, splintered into fine slivers and only superficially wounded Murphy in the left leg. Murphy examined his bloodied leg through torn trousers and applied first aid to the bleeding leg.
